QUESTION 1: How old were you when the event occurred? Did you have a role before, during or after the emergency?

QUESTION 2: Did you have children when the emergency occurred? If yes, how did they experience the situation?

QUESTION 3: Did younger people participate in any way before, during or after the event?

QUESTION 4: Was the community prepared for the emergency?

QUESTION 5: Were you prepared for the event?

QUESTION 6: How did you react to the event? How did the people around you react?

QUESTION 7: What feelings do you associate with the event? Do you remember particular sounds, smells or colours?

QUESTION 8: Were there organisations involved in emergency prevention?

QUESTION 9: How was the emergency phase dealt with?

QUESTION 10: Did you notice teams of volunteers? Were you part of them?

QUESTION 11: How did the community cope with the event?

QUESTION 12: In your opinion, what measures would have been necessary to limit the effects of such a calamitous event?

QUESTION 13: Had the territory been affected by the same event before? If yes, how long before?

QUESTION 14: Did any aspect of the previous event help the community to prepare for or cope with the event you experienced?
