SCENARIOS

SCENARIO 1

You are on holiday with your parents on a small island in the Mediterranean. Your parents know the island well because they have been there many times. your neighbours are a couple of gentlemen who do not speak the local language and only know a few words in English to communicate. They are travellers and will stay a few days and then move on. A wave of bad weather hits the island and the small town is completely flooded. Connections to the mainland are disrupted.

- **Vulnerability detected:** language misunderstanding and lack of knowledge of the territory.

SCENARIO 2

A young couple with a newborn son and a 5-year-old daughter live in your building. They have recently moved in and do not yet know anyone in the building. One night a strong earthquake hits your town and many buildings are damaged, fortunately there are no victims. The inhabitants of the building do not know what to do, whether to stay at home or sleep somewhere else. Your new neighbours are very worried and do not know what to do. They cannot leave the city for work reasons.

- **Vulnerability detected:** presence of children.

SCENARIO 3

A classmate of yours lives in a small town not far from yours. The girl is visually impaired and lives with her parents who are away all day for work. One afternoon she invites you to go to her house to do your homework. It's the two of you and her elderly grandmother. At some point you start to smell something burning and realise that a socket has short-circuited and is catching fire.

- **Vulnerability detected:** visually impaired girl and elderly woman.
